



Where Will We Call Home?

Kincort is a short street running north of Castlefield, west of Caledonia and east of Keele. Just to the south-west is the Harold and Grace Baker Centre, a Revera retirement and long term care facility.

The hospice will serve residents of North York, East York, Leaside and Scarborough where no residential hospice exists.

The hospice will also assist visiting hospice services and provide space for doctors to offer pain management out of hospital, taking a burden off hospitals.

What Can I Do?

The next step is to go through the planning procedure with the City. To do this, our architects and engineers are working to develop the necessary plans, but there is something more. Planners need to know that you care, that a Hospice is indeed something that the people of Toronto need and want.

To address this, we have drafted a letter to the Committee of Adjustments. You can write a similar letter expressing your concerns and emphasizing the need for more residential hospice beds. We have provided a letter for those who are willing to sign it and send it to us so that we can illustrate your support.
